Teresa presented highlights of the year in review:

- Meetings: The Fall meeting (Oct. 2005) on Evidence Based Clinical Practice, presented by Dean Giustini, Vicki Lee, Tricia Yu, was held at BC Cancer Agency and videoconferenced to Kamloops, Kelowna and Victoria (attendance: 24 – 16 in person + 8 by videoconference)
- A January meeting and social brunch was held at VGH (attendance: 26).
- The Spring meeting (March 2006) on History of Opioids & Pain Management: How the Information has Changed by Dr. Romayne Gallagher - held at Sunny Hill Health Centre for Children and videoconferenced to Kelowna, Nanaimo and Victoria (attendance: 14 – 12 in person + 2 by videoconference)
- AGM is being held in May, rather than June this year, to fall at the end of the Vancouver CHLA conference, to allow out-

- of-town members to more easily attend.
- Continuing Education: No spring CE this year. Using the CHLA conference for our CE
- Videoconferencing: Last spring meeting was HLABC's first use of videoconferencing. This year, we videoconferenced the 2 regular meetings (fall and spring) and their presentations. Note: computer graphics not always clear on videoconference. Presenters are asked to e-mail PowerPoint prior to meeting for offsite participants
- UBC lowered ILL rates to \$5 for HLABC members, starting Jan. 2006. Leonora Crema, UBC Library's Head of Borrower Services is the contact. Is working well for both UBC and HLABC.
- Honourary Lifetime Membership Award presented Jan. 2006 to Sue Abzinger (now retired from Fraser Health Authority and Royal Columbian Hospital) for her contributions to HLABC and BC health libraries over 30 years
